

## AARON LLOYD IT SCHOLARSHIP

### The Scholarship

This scholarship has been established in memory of Aaron Lloyd. Its purpose is to encourage young people from the Clutha District to pursue further study in Information Technology. The scholarship provides \$500 cash to the successful recipient payable in March of the year of study.

### Eligibility

Applications are accepted from residents of the Clutha District who are under the age of 21 and studying, or about to study IT related subjects at Polytechnic or University in Otago. An applicant may apply more than once.

The scholarship is offered annually however its awarding is at the sole discretion of Shand Thomson.

### Aaron Lloyd

Aaron joined Shand Thomson when he was 16 years old. He worked for the firm for 27 years holding the position of IT Manager from 2001 to 2016. His self taught, learnt "on the job" IT skills were considerable and he was generous in sharing them with his co-workers and the Clutha community.

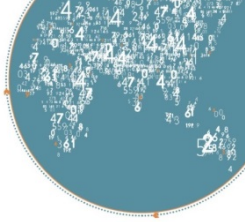

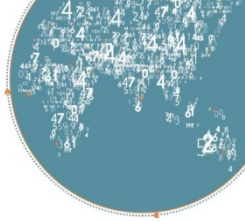
